Don't shy away or fuss too much about writing style: you'd be amazed at how well articles read once they are in print. Plus, we can always help with the editing. Articles may be submitted at any time, and the approximate deadlines for inclusion in a specific issue of the *Bulletin* are March 15, June 30, September 15 and December 15. A couple of *caveats*: 1) please do not submit material in “read-only” PDF format, as they are difficult to edit; and 2) the placement of images in your submission are welcome, but please understand that the *Bulletin's* superb designer has to fit each article into the parameters of a 16 or 20 page publication, so there may have to be some movement. If you imbed images into the text, please send them separately as well. Overwhelm me with material, people! You don't want to have to read my prattle more than once every couple of issues.
