Slightly domed advertising pot lid, 2.8 to 3.07 inch diameter. English producer/supplier located in London, England. Black print with yellow printed background or glaze; green leaves and red cherries under or over the glaze; there is also a variant without color on the cherries or leaves. One of three versions of this lid, the others being "Thompson, Walters, Hole" and "Chemists Association" (both included in this Database), all three located at the same address. This pattern predates the other two;
