

Save the dates for the 2019 TCC Annual Meeting!



The TCC is pleased to announce that Birmingham, Alabama has been selected as the site of the 2019 Annual Meeting, to be held on October 17 - 20. A collaboration with the Birmingham Museum of Art (BMA) will provide meeting attendees with a unique opportunity to view and study the renowned BMA ceramics collection. The BMA has the largest and most comprehensive collection of Wedgwood ceramics outside of England: the Buten Wedgwood Collection of more than 8,000 objects made by the Wedgwood factory in England dating from 1759, and the Dwight and Lucille Beeson Wedgwood Collection of more than 1,400 objects.

A dynamic roster of speakers will highlight the contributions of the Wedgwood factory and its competitors, and will also focus on many other facets of transferware: the translation of artistic concepts into patterns and production, the Romantic genre, the influence of botanical design, and the widespread use of British transferware in the American South. A visit to the Arlington Antebellum Home and Gardens will highlight regional history and Southern culture. The Annual Meeting will also include the ever-popular Transferware Sale, the Show and Discuss Evening, and the Transferware Raffle.

Conference sessions will be held at the Birmingham Museum of Art as well as at the conference hotel, an iconic historic landmark, The Tutwiler, which is conveniently located within one block of the Birmingham Museum of Art and just a short distance from the Birmingham International Airport.
